GUIDELINES

Art and Craft Exhibitors will be allowed to sell and display products and other materials from 10:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, July 10th, 2010. Set-up will begin at 7:30 a.m. All booths should be set-up and ready by 9:00 a.m.

Participants are responsible for tables, chairs, tents, extension cords, and other supplies needed for booth set-up. Electric hook-ups are available on a limited basis at the top of the street light poles.

Assistance will be available to connect on a first come, first served basis. Exhibitors requiring electricity should bring their own extension cords.

Booth applications must be received by Friday, June 1, 2010. Spaces will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. Booth numbers, a festival layout map, and further information will be mailed out of the Uptown Greenwood Development Corporation office on Friday, June 18, 2010.

A \$10 fee has been added to the fee for booth registration in order to meet the City of Greenwood business licensing requirements for this event. Individual business licenses from each vendor **will not** be required.
