The Rules

- Must be 18 years of age to enter
- Contestants may not touch the Hot Dogs until the starting signal
- Only entire Hot Dogs eaten will be counted (An entire Hot Dog includes the bun)
- Contestants will have 12 minutes to down all the Hot Dogs they can handle
- Contestants may drink water while eating their Hot Dogs
- Buns and Hot Dogs may be separated, dunked or mangled. All portions of the Hot Dog (including bun) must be eaten
- When the 12-minute time limit is up, contestants may not put any additional Hot Dogs or Buns in their mouths. They will then have 20 seconds to swallow what is in their mouths. Any contents remaining in contestant's mouths at the end of the 20 seconds will not be counted
- Partially eaten Hot Dogs will not be counted
- Visible signs of sickness will result in disqualification
- Ties will be decided by an "eat off"
