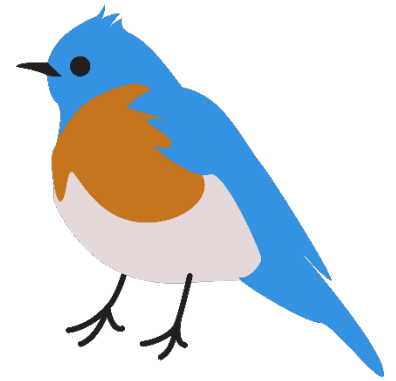


TWEET ON MAIN STREET



1) Skyy – Blue Jay

- a. To find Skyy, a great place to start, is just past the place to see great art. You will find her perched up high with a flowing waterfall nearby.

2) Hover – Ruby-Throated Hummingbird

- a. Hover is quite an amazing site. Hard to see when he is in flight. Roam the Courtyard near the Center of Art. Be sure to find him before you depart.

Clue: Search in the Arts Center courtyard

3) Rusty – American Robin

- a. At the corner of Main & Maxwell, turn on a dime and you will find Rusty singing a song and making a home in the nick of time.

4) Sunny – American Goldfinch

- a. Look for Sunny where kids come to splash and play, cooling off on a hot day. She has landed where the flowers grow, with lots of beautiful blossoms to show.

Clue: Search at the Uptown Market area

5) Cheedee – Carolina Chickadee

- a. Cheedee is resting in a spot where locals like to grab a bite and shop. You can even take a swing. If you listen closely, you may hear him sing.

Clue: Search at Main Street and Oak Avenue

6) Chipper – Red-Headed Woodpecker

- a. Chipper is very hard to see! You will need to look carefully. He is looking near the skylights for a place to peck. To find him you really need to stretch your neck.

Clue: Search the Uptown Fountain area

7) Chirp – Northern Cardinal

- a. Chirp can see colorful water rise and fall, from his place high on a branch, where he is perched so tall.

- b. **Clue:** Search the Uptown Fountain area

8) Tweet – Eastern Carolina Blue Bird

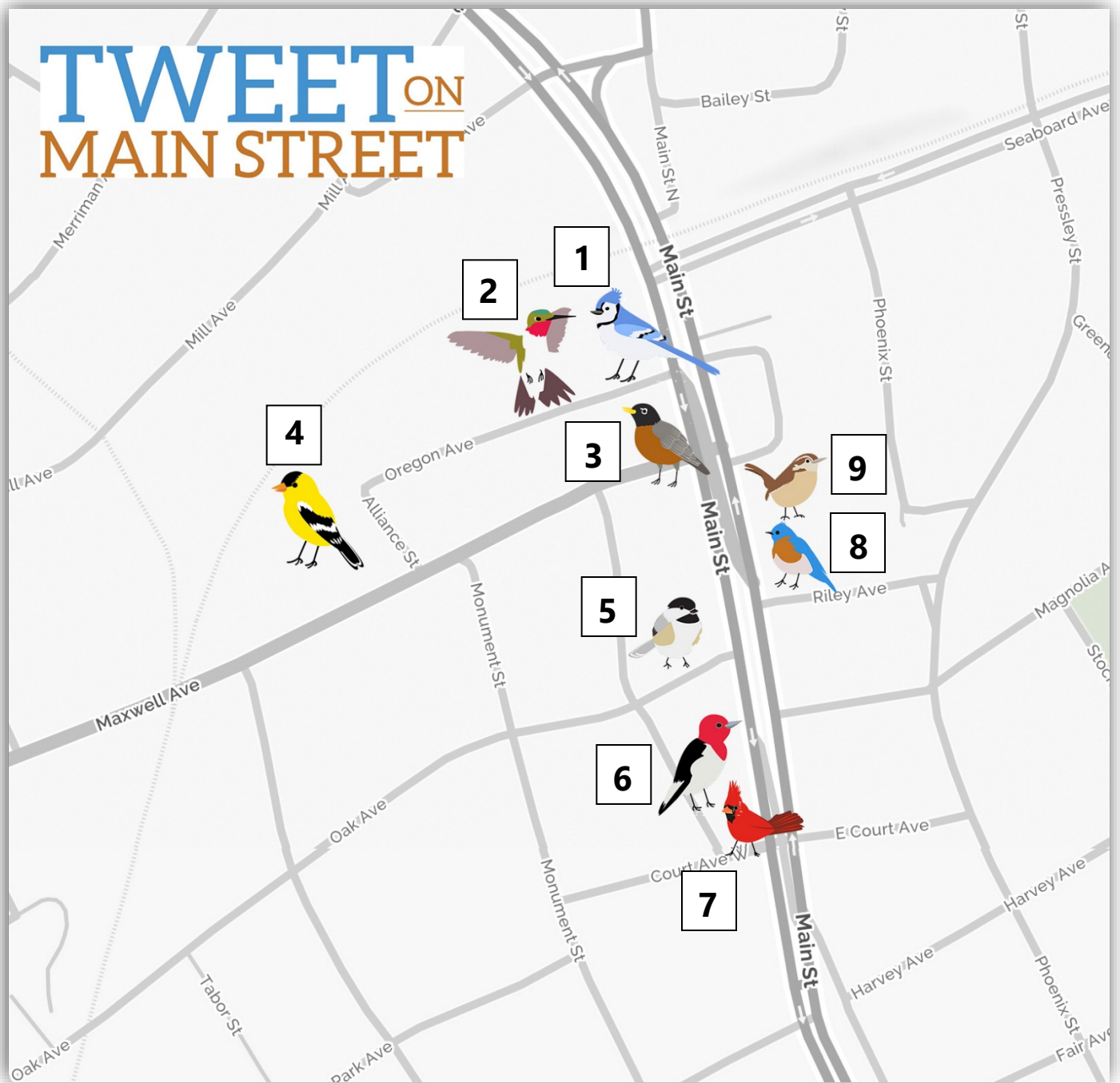
- a. You will find Tweet having a snack. He is very easy to track. Look in front of the building named Grier. You will find Tweet eating here.

Clue: Search at Main and Riley.

9) Wrennie – Carolina Wren

- a. To look for Wrennie, you will find your mark, if you go towards windows that are dark. He makes a nest at Riley and Main. You will find water below his domain.
